WHEREAS: Service Contract 75LX332, dated November 22, 2017, provided \$573,750.00 to City of Santa Clara for the installation of railroad/highway grade crossing safety improvements in the City of Santa Clara at the grade crossing located at the intersection of Agnew Road and Union Pacific Railroad Company's tracks identified as California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) No. 001L-41.60/SCL-1231, Federal DOT No. 749965G.

WHEREAS, Amendment Nos. 1, 2 and 3 extended the Service Contract through June 30, 2024 and;

WHEREAS, Amendment No. 4, The original scope was being modified to include advanced traffic signal preemption as an integrated safety feature thereby requiring at least 24 months additional contract time through June 30, 2026 to determine exact changes to scope, schedule, and budget and;

WHEREAS, Amendment No. 5, The project was delayed for unforeseen circumstances; therefore, the funds are reduced by **\$(-561,597.51)** and the net contract amount will be \$12,152.49 of what the City invoiced.

NOW THEREFORE, it is mutually agreed by the parties hereto; that all terms and conditions of Service Contract 75LX332 as amended shall remain in full force and effect, except the contract dollar amount shall be changed to \$12,152.49, and the expiration date shall now be June 30, 2026.

NOW THEREFORE, it is mutually agreed by the parties hereto; that all terms and conditions of Service Contract 75LX332 as amended shall remain in full force and effect, except the contract dollar amount shall be amended with \$4,374,000.00 of additional funds for a total contract value of \$4,386,152.49, and the expiration date shall now be June 30, 2026.
