#### Commemorative Months

**April:** Jazz Appreciation Month

 Jazz Appreciation Month (fondly known as "JAM") was first designated by the National Museum of American History in 2001 to recognize and celebrate the extraordinary heritage and history of jazz for the entire month of April.

May: Asian/Pacific American – and- Jewish Heritage

  - Apr 25-Participation in Arbor Day field trips with SCUSD (900 students)


