**WHEREAS**, the City of Santa Clara's Charter section 1310 requires all contracts involving an expenditure of over \$1,000 for public works to be let to the lowest responsible bidder;

**WHEREAS**, Charter section 1310 permits the City to use its own employees if the City Council determines that the public works may be done better or more economically by the City's own employees, and, upon such determination, the City may proceed to have the public works done without further observance of Charter section 1310;

**WHEREAS**, the City's Water Utility desires to perform certain public works, including the installation of water services, as set forth in the Report to Council dated August 21,2018, by its own employees;

**WHEREAS**, the City's Water and Sewer Utilities has in-house knowledge and trained personnel operating and maintaining the water system that can be leveraged to complete the limited size and scope of this work more economically than by outside contractors; and,

# NOW THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF SANTA CLARA AS FOLLOWS:

The City Council of the City of Santa Clara does hereby declare and determine that the public works set forth in the August 21, 2018 Report to Council, attached hereto and incorporated by this reference, may be performed better or more economically by the City with its own employees.

### REPORT TO COUNCIL

### **SUBJECT**

Action on a Resolution for the Use of City Water Forces at Two Park Locations

#### BACKGROUND

Charter Section 1310 titled Contracts on Public Works states in part, "that every contract involving an expenditure of more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) for the construction or improvement (excluding maintenance and repair) of public buildings, works, streets, drains, sewers, utilities, parks and playgrounds shall be let to the lowest responsible bidder." The section further states that "the City Council may declare and determine that, in its opinion, the work in question may be performed better or more economically by the City with its own employees, and after the adoption of a resolution to this effect by at least four affirmative votes, it may proceed to have said work done in the manner stated, without further observance of the provisions of this section."

#### DISCUSSION

Staff believes that the work described below would be better performed with City Forces to complete the limited size and scope of work outline below. The Water Utility has in-house knowledge and trained personnel operating and maintaining water services that can be leveraged to more economically perform this work. Bidding out the work separately and contracting with a private entity would delay the construction projects. Therefore, staff recommends that the City Council find that City Forces can best perform the following water utility services and approve the use of City Forces.

Location(s): Machado Park at 3360 Cabrillo Avenue, and Bowers Park at

2582 Cabrillo Avenue

Type of Service: Provide new installation and upgrade services for new public

water improvements.

Description of Work: Upgrade existing four 2" water services, installation of two new

2" water services and abandonment of existing one 2" water

service.

Estimated Cost: \$53,814.52
