## **RESOLUTION NO. 20-8875**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SANTA CLARA, CALIFORNIA NAMING A NEW ROADWAY, WITHIN THE CITY'S FORMER GOLF COURSE AND CLOSED LANDFILL, CONNECTING FROM GREAT AMERICA PARKWAY TO STARS AND STRIPES DRIVE TO BE KNOWN AS STARS AND STRIPES DRIVE

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF SANTA CLARA AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, on June 28, 2016, the Santa Clara City Council approved a number of entitlements for the proposed construction by Related Santa Clara, LLC (the "Developer") of a new multiphased, mixed-use development known as the Related Santa Clara Project (the "Project") on City owned property;

**WHEREAS**, the Developer constructed an approximately 3,570-foot long temporary public street connecting Great America Parkway to Stars and Stripes Drive;

**WHEREAS**, a map depicting the approximately 3,570-foot long temporary public street, Stars and Stripes Drive, located east of Great America Parkway, is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated fully herein by this reference; and,

**WHEREAS**, Streets and Highways Code Section 5026 provides that the City Council may by resolution change the name of any street located within the City.

## NOW THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF SANTA CLARA AS FOLLOWS:

- That the temporary roadway yet to be named, located to the east of Great America
   Parkway, within the City's former golf course and closed landfill, connecting to Stars and Stripes
   Drive, is hereby named Stars and Stripes Drive.
- 2. That the City Clerk is directed to file a copy of this resolution with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors and the Surveyor of Santa Clara County.
- 3. The Building Official is directed to administer the name change in accordance with the procedures specified in City Manager Directive #5.

- 5. <u>Effective date</u>. This resolution shall become effective immediately.
