

**AMENDMENT NO. 2
TO THE AGREEMENT FOR SERVICES
BETWEEN THE
CITY OF SANTA CLARA, CALIFORNIA,
AND
MCCAMPBELL ANALYTICAL, INC.**

PREAMBLE

This agreement ("Amendment No. 2") is entered into between the City of Santa Clara, California, a chartered California municipal corporation (City) and McCampbell Analytical, Inc. a California corporation (Contractor). City and Contractor may be referred to individually as a "Party" or collectively as the "Parties" or the "Parties to this Agreement."

RECITALS

- A. The Parties previously entered into an agreement entitled "Agreement For Services Between The City Of Santa Clara, California and McCampbell Analytical, Inc., dated October 21, 2020 (Agreement); and
- B. The Agreement was previously amended by Amendment No. 1, dated September 15, 2025, and is again amended by this Amendment No. 2. The Agreement and all previous amendments are collectively referred to herein as the "Agreement as Amended."
- C. The Parties entered into the Agreement for the purpose of having Contractor provide bacteriological water quality lab services, and the Parties now wish to amend the Agreement to extend the term and increase maximum compensation by \$150,000 from \$266,719 for a revised not-to-exceed amount of \$416,719.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties agree as follows:

AMENDMENT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. Section 2 of the Agreement, entitled "TERM OF AGREEMENT" is amended to read as follows:
 - A. Unless otherwise set forth in this Agreement or unless this paragraph is subsequently modified by a written amendment to this Agreement, the Initial Term of this Agreement will begin on July 1, 2020 and terminate on June 30, 2027.
- 2. Exhibit B of the Agreement, entitled "SCHEDULE OF FEES" is hereby revised and replaced with the Second Revised Exhibit B, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this Amendment No. 2.
- 3. Except as set forth herein, all other terms and conditions of the Agreement will remain in full force and effect. In case of a conflict in the terms of the Agreement and this Amendment No. 2, the provisions of this Amendment No. 2 will control.

The Parties acknowledge and accept the terms and conditions of this Amendment No. 2 as evidenced by the following signatures of their duly authorized representatives.

**SECOND REVISED EXHIBIT B
SCHEDULE OF FEES**

1. MAXIMUM COMPENSATION

The maximum compensation the City will pay Contractor for all professional fees, costs and expenses provided under this Agreement will not exceed four hundred sixteen thousand, seven hundred nineteen dollars (\$416,719).

2. INVOICING

Contractor will bill City on a monthly basis for Services provided by Contractor during the preceding month on an invoice and in a format approved by City and subject to verification and approval by City. City will pay Contractor within thirty (30) days of City's receipt of an approved invoice.

3. FEE SCHEDULE

3.2 Additional Services

The City will provide Contractor with details of the additional services requested and Contractor will provide a written quote for the requested services. City will provide written authorization to proceed with the additional service upon their review and approval of the quote. At no time will Contractor provide additional services without the prior written authorization from the City to proceed. City will not compensate Contractor for any additional services completed without prior written authorization permitting Contractor to proceed with such work.
