I, Rhiannon Paterniti, hereby request that the following item be placed on the City of Santa Clara Council and Authorities Concurrent Meeting Agenda:

Extend the city's goal of "Enhancing Community Sports and Recreational Assets" to help address the substantial lack of designated cricket facilities within the South Bay area in general, and namely, the City of Santa Clara itself. While Bay Area leagues and players currently make do with multi-use fields as their grounds, the lack of designated cricket pitches significantly detracts from their ability to play the sport in it's authentic form, specifically by not allowing for 360 degrees of play in most cases. I'm sure you will find that there is significant demand for these facilities as indicated by the Bay Area Cricket Alliance (<http://www.bayareacricket.org/>), California Cricket Academy (<https://www.calcricket.org/>), Cricbay (<http://www.cricbay.com/>), the Tennisball Cricket Association (<http://tennisballcricket.com/>), and the active cricket clubs in practically every municipality in the South Bay.
