Santa Clara Unified School District, Family Child Education Services, is requesting the current funding in the amount of \$108,450 from the City of Santa Clara. These funds help support up to 16 low-income families living within Santa Clara allowing us to serve K-5<sup>th</sup> grade children in our year round before and after school and summer camp enrichment programs across 11 Santa Clara Unified Elementary Schools. Currently, we are serving 13 students between Bracher, Hughes, Pomeroy, and Westwood.

Our experienced teachers provide a safe, supervised, hands-on learning environment for students. We provide homework support, developmentally appropriate educational and enrichment activities, and creative learning environments. We partner with school faculty and staff to ensure our program goals align with the schools educational goals as well as with each child's unique skills and interest.

Our programs support the community by reducing the number of latch key children. Through homework support, engaging intellectual and kinesthetic activities we are able to support low income working families.

We sincerely appreciate the funding the City provides for us to make a difference in the lives of children and families who are less fortunate.



- Supplies for small group and large group activities, STEAM, clubs, camp weeks (full day services), as well as food for breakfast and snack.



- Supplies for small group and large group activities, STEAM, clubs, camp weeks (full day services for February and April camp weeks), as well as food for breakfast and snack.


