Charlie Tucker

- Charlie Tucker was born in Cherry County, Valentine, Nebraska, on Christmas Eve, 1937
- Charlie married his wife Julie in 1962 and welcomed their daughter, Dawn in 1966.
- Charlie graduated from Santa Clara University College of Law in 1973 and practiced family law. He became an entrepreneur and managed an executive recruitment agency for 15 years before “retiring” to follow his love of history.
- This passion led him to become a preservationist, restoring a couple of historical homes in The Old Quad area of Santa Clara.
- After having their home included in the 1992 Home Tour, Charlie joined the Home Tour Committee. He photographed homes for artists to sketch for the Home Tour programs for 26 years.
- In the early 90s, Charlie volunteered at the Harris-Lass Museum and served as President of the Board of Directors. He served on the local Habitat for Humanity Board for 15 years and was instrumental in working with the City of Santa Clara to build homes for several deserving families.
- Charlie loved sharing laughter, stories, and his extensive wisdom with his friends and family, especially his two grandsons who benefitted greatly.
