EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The date of July 19, 2016 is requested to be set for consideration of the Santa Clara County Agricultural Commissioner's Weed Abatement Program and Assessment Report ("Weed Assessment Report"). The Weed Abatement Report provides the City a list of properties that did not comply with the weed abatement notices and properties that the County conducted their abatement services and associated costs. The public notice for a hearing is required in accordance with Chapter 8.15 of the City Municipal Code.

ADVANTAGES AND DISADVANTAGES OF ISSUE

The Weed Assessment Report will allow the City to mitigate any highlighted hazards associated with dried vegetation. The County provides the abatement services while minimizing the effect on burrowing owls. Providing notice of public hearing will allow members of the public to voice any concerns regarding the Weed Assessment Report. No disadvantages can be identified.

ECONOMIC/FISCAL IMPACT

The County manages the Weed Abatement Program and all fees are collected through the County Assessor's Office. There is no cost to the City other than staff time and expense.

RECOMMENDATION

That the Council:

- 1. Set July 19, 2016 as the date for a public hearing for adoption of a resolution confirming the report on the cost of weed abatement and making assessments to pay the related costs and expenses in conjunction with the 2016 Weed Abatement Program.
- 2. Authorize the publication and posting of the Notice of the Public Hearing.
