# NURC Background

- **Established in 1990** to review student housing issues (formerly Student Housing Committee)
- **June 2006, Council combined the Santa Clara University/City Liaison Committee and the NURC.** NURC has been a forum for on-going communication and problem solving among City officials, neighborhoods, property owners and Santa Clara University (SCU) officials and students.
- **June 23, 2009,** NURC established a schedule of 3 meetings per year (October /November, February and April/May) to allow for more time for dialogue.



# Approved Restructure

The Restructure of NURC Committee includes seven members:

- Two City Council members (versus the three members) – appointed by Council
- Two SCU representatives - selected by SCU
- One SCU student – selected by SCU
- One neighborhood representative Old Quad Neighborhood
- One property owner/landlord representative
