Background

- 10/11/22: City receives Written Petition from Mr. Kirk Vartan regarding "the new parking permit ordinance and rules."
- 11/01/22: Council discusses petition and directs staff to return at a future Council meeting
- 01/10/23: Staff provides informational report to Council related to the existing parking zones from the petition.

Two Types of Parking Zones

- Department of Public Works, Traffic Engineering create/modify parking zones in the City
- Two main types of Parking Zones:
 - 1. Time-Limited & Restricted Parking Zones
 - 2. Residential Permit Parking Program (RPPP) Zones
- Both zones are implemented based on resident/property owner request and have differing outreach processes



Time-Limited & Restricted Parking Zones

- Time-Limited:
 - 1-hour, 2-hour, during specific times of the day and week
- Restricted Permit Parking Zones
 - · White, yellow, green, blue, and red curb zones
- Outreach to directly adjacent properties.
- Neighborhood vote <u>not required</u>

Residential Permit Parking Program Zones

- 2003 Council approves Ordinance 10.40 creating Residential Permit Parking Program (RPPP)
- Establish zones in residential neighborhoods where street parking is allowed "by permit only"
- Guidelines to establish RPPP zones (6 steps)
 - 1) property owner RPPP request
- 4) permit parking needs analysis
- 2) initial City coordination
- 5) final property owner ballot
- 3) initial property owner ballot
- 6) City Council final review/approval.

Resident Parking ONLY With Femil ANYTIME



Two Types of Permit Parking Programs

- Police Department administers permit parking in Santa Clara
- Two types of permit parking (correlate to parking zones):
 - 1. Preferential On-Street Parking Permits
 - 2. Residential Parking Permits
- To simplify public information and outreach both programs were combined under the title "Residential Permit Parking"

Preferential On-Street Parking Permits

- August 1990 Council adopts Resolution 5544 authorizing the Police Department to issue parking permits to residents who reside on Preferential Parking Streets
- Preferential Parking Streets time limited parking zones on residential streets
- Permits allow residents to park outside of specified time allotments on these streets



Residential Parking Permits

- 2003 Council approves Ordinance 10.40 creating Residential Permit Parking Program (RPPP)
- If RPPP zone is established, Police can issue parking permits to residents to park in RPPP zones

Permit Parking Programs & Covid-19 Pandemic

- During Covid-19 Pandemic, Police Department enforcement of Permit parking programs was dormant
- Oct thru Dec 2022 Police Department begins outreach regarding return of permit parking enforcement on January 1, 2023
- Outreach tools City publications, Police Department website,
 Facebook, Instagram, Nextdoor, Nixle, Twitter,
 A-frame signs messages on the affected streets



Return of Permit Parking Program

- Return on January 1, 2023
- New third-party parking permit vendor providing:
 - virtual, contactless application
 - Payment and permit management
 - 24 hours/day & 365 days a year
- Vehicles license plates registered with parking permit system replaces parking stickers/hang tags.
