Under Section 1094.6, any lawsuit or legal challenge to any quasi-judicative decision made by the City must be filed no later than the 90th day following the date on which such decision becomes final. Any lawsuit or legal challenge, which is not filed within that 90-day period, will be barred. If a person wishes to challenge the nature of the above section in court, they may be limited to raising only those issues they or someone else raised at the meeting described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City of Santa Clara, at or prior to the meeting. In addition, judicial challenge may be limited or barred where the interested party has not sought and exhausted all available administrative remedies.

SUBJECT

Adopt a Resolution Declaring the Results of the Canvass of Returns of the Consolidated Municipal General Election held on November 5, 2024 with the Statewide Presidential Election

COUNCIL PILLAR

Enhance Community Engagement and Transparency

BACKGROUND

A Consolidated Municipal General Election was held on November 5, 2024 with the Statewide Presidential Election. California elections Code Section 9296 and 10262 require that the City Council adopt a Resolution reciting the facts of the election no later than the next regularly scheduled City Council meeting following presentation of the 30-day canvass of returns.

DISCUSSION

Consistent with the California Elections Code, staff brings forward this report and has prepared a resolution for adoption. Attached is the official canvass of the returns of said election with the appropriate provisions of the California Elections Code. The results of said election is as follows:

Per the City Charter, for the positions of Chief of Police, City Clerk and District Councilmembers, the candidate receiving the most votes is the winner. Accordingly, the following individuals are the winners of their respective seats:

Chief of Police:	Cory Morgan

Per Article XIII A of the California Constitution, to be approved, the “Yes” vote in favor of Measure I must secure 66.7% or greater of the votes cast. Since the “Yes” vote on Measure secured 69% of the votes cast, Measure I was approved by the voters.

Legal Requirements and Effects of the Election Certification Process

Under the City Charter, unless an express provision of the Charter provides otherwise, City elections are governed by the California Elections Code [Charter Section 700]. With respect to election certification, there are no Charter provisions providing otherwise.

Under the Elections Code, section 10262 requires the elections official to conduct the canvass of votes (i.e., count the votes cast in the election), pursuant to its sections 15302 and 15303. “Upon the completion of the canvass, the elections official shall certify the results to the governing body.” (Elec. Code § 12062.) The canvass must be completed by the fourth Friday after the election (Elec. Code § 10262, subd. (a)), and for a consolidated election, the elections official shall certify the results to the governing body, and the governing body *must* certify the election results in compliance with section 10263 by its next regularly scheduled meeting after the 28-day canvass or at a special meeting called for that purpose. (Elec. Code § 10262, subd. (b).) Elections Code section 10263 requires the governing body to adopt a resolution reciting “the fact of the election and the other matters that are enumerated in section 10264.” The governing body must also “declare the results and ... install the newly elected officers.” (Ibid., subd. (a).)

Although the certification process described above, is mandatory, election certification does not definitely decide the outcome of every election contest. Even after “certification” there are separate legal processes for challenging the outcome of an election, or the qualifications of an elected candidate to hold office. The first such process is contained in Elections Code Section 16100. The second such process is known as a “quo warranto” proceeding.

Elections Code Section 16100. Most of the bases for challenge to an election under Elections Code 16100 relate to elections official misconduct, material vote counting errors, or the casting of illegal votes. Section 16100(b) also provides for an election challenge based on a determination that a person elected was not, at the time of the election, eligible to hold office. Under Section 16401(d) a statement of such challenge must be filed with the superior court within 30 days after the City’s certification of the subject election.

Quo Warranto. A quo warranto action must either be initiated by the City Council or be initiated or authorized by the State Attorney General. A quo warranto action doesn’t relate to the election itself, but to the qualifications of a party to run for or hold a public office under applicable law. Applicable laws include federal, state or local laws, which would include the City’s own Charter requirements. Quo warranto actions can be initiated at any time during the tenure of an elected official.

Either form of elections challenge, whether under the Elections Code or a quo warranto proceeding, may be initiated by the City Council itself or an individual “elector” within the City; provided, however, as discussed above, any proposed quo warranto action by an individual elector must first be approved by the Attorney General.

FISCAL IMPACT

There was no fiscal impact in the preparation of this report.

WHEREAS, a Consolidated Municipal Election was held with the Statewide Presidential Election and conducted in the City of Santa Clara, on Tuesday, November 5, 2024, as required by law;

WHEREAS, notice of the election was given in time, form and manner as provided by law; that voting precincts were properly established; that election officers were appointed and that in all respects the election was held and conducted and the votes were cast, received and canvassed and the returns made and declared in time, form and manner as required by the provisions of the Elections Code of the State of California for holding of elections in charter cities; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 24-9336 (a resolution calling for a consolidated general municipal election to be held on November 5, 2024 with the Statewide Presidential election) adopted on June 25, 2024; and Resolution No. 24-9347 (a resolution calling for a consolidated special municipal election to be held on November 5, 2024 with the Statewide Presidential election) adopted on July 16, 2024, the County Registrar of Voters canvassed the returns of the election and has certified to this City Council, the results are received, attached and made part of hereof as Exhibit A and B.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF SANTA CLARA AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the total number of votes (ballots): 44,129
2. That the names of the persons voted for at the election for Chief of Police: Cory B. Morgan, for City Clerk: Bob O’Keefe, for Councilmember in Council District 1: Albert Gonzalez, for Councilmember in Council District 4: Kevin Nara Park, for Councilmember in Council District 5: Sudhanshu “Suds” Jain, and for Councilmember in Council District 6: Kelly G. Cox.

3. That the number of votes given at each district and precinct and the number of votes given in the City to the persons named above for the respective offices for which the persons were a candidate are listed in the attached Exhibits A and B.

4. That the City Council does declare and determine that: Cory B. Morgan was elected as Chief of Police, Bob O’Keefe was elected as City Clerk, Albert Gonzalez was elected as Councilmember in Council District 1, Kevin Nara Park was elected as Councilmember in Council District 4, Sudhanshu “Suds” Jain was elected as Councilmember in Council District 5, and Kelly G. Cox was elected as Councilmember in Council District 6, each for a four-year term ending 2028.

5. That the City does declare and determine that City of Santa Clara Measure I to approve the Issuance of General Obligation Bond passed with the following results: votes in favor of Measure I – 28,133; and votes against Measure I – 12,399.

6. That the Assistant City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter into the book of original resolutions.

7. Constitutionality, severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this resolution is for any reason held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid for any reason such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the resolution. The City of Santa Clara, California, hereby declares that it would have passed this resolution and each section, subsection, sentence, clause phrase, and word thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more section(s), subsection(s), sentence(s), clause(s), phrase(s), or word(s) be declared invalid.
