Anne Mulcrevy Holder, Longtime Santa Clara Business Owner

- Anne Mulcrevy Holder was born in San Francisco on July 18, 1923 to Frank and Cecile Mulcrevy.
- She met the love of her life, Jack Holder, in a train derailment in January 1952, and they were married in 1954.
- They moved to "The Valley of Heart's Delight" in 1957 and raised a family of 7 children.
- Anne and her husband owned and operated Uncle John's Pancake House in Santa Clara, and then in 1967 founded Holder's Country Inn which is now run by their children. They spent 41 years in marriage until his passing in 1996.
- Anne passed away peacefully at home with her family at her side on Thanksgiving Day.
- Anne is survived by her children, Jacqueline, Frank, John, Richard, Dan, Michael, and Robert, 12 grandchildren, 11 great-grandchildren, and many nieces, nephews, and cousins.

- Anthony was born on August 3, 1983 in Youngstown, OH, and graduated from Cardinal Mooney High School, where he lettered in football and baseball.
