WHEREAS, a common gynecological disease, the causes for the development of endometriosis are not currently understood and there is no cure for endometriosis, but treatments are available for its symptoms; and

WHEREAS, starting in 1993, Endometriosis Awareness Week, which expanded to Endometriosis Awareness Month, serves as a time to raise awareness about the condition and treatment; and

WHEREAS, addressing endometriosis will empower those affected by supporting their right to the highest standard of sexual and reproductive health, quality of life, and overall wellbeing.
