

- 7b. Briefly describe the present *physical description* of the site or structure and describe any major alterations from its original condition:

1511 Harrison is a small, one-story Italianate cottage. Its asymmetrical plan and complex rooflines are unusual for the style and may be the result of various additions. Brackets under the eaves and the narrow, elongated windows used throughout the house are Italianate features. Two slanted bay windows are separated by slender colonettes. Contrasting colors enhance the bay's details, including the recessed panels beneath the windows. Located on a corner lot, the house is partially obscured by trees and shrubbery.


19. Briefly state historical and/or architectural importance (include dates, events, and persons associated with the site.)

1511 Harrison is significant for its architectural style, a variation of the Italianate cottage. While it is not eligible for listing on the National Register, it represents a significant local resource. Estimated date of construction is sometime during the 1880's, the house appears on the 1891 Sanborn Fire Insurance Map. The original owner of the house is not known at this time.
