Please place on the agenda for the September 27, 2022 City Council meeting a vote to agendaize a public review of the Settlement Agreement and Mutual Release dated August 31, 2022 between the City of Santa Clara, the Santa Clara Stadium Authority, and the 49er football team entities. Despite requests from the Santa Clara public to have a discussion on elements of the proposed settlement agreement after the 49ers released the major details of the offer to the media, there was no public discussion of the merits of the offer. After the City Council returned from closed session during the August 30, 2022 Combined City Council and Stadium Authority meeting, the Interim City Attorney stated that there was "no reportable action." Santa Clara has not publicly made any announcement related to this significant agreement. The members of the Santa Clara public are owed a detailed explanation of the elements of the settlement, its impact on past disputes and future relationship with the 49ers and health of the Stadium Authority. Santa Clarans deserve to know why each council member either supported or did not support this settlement. Please be transparent with your public and schedule a full and public discussion of this settlement agreement as soon as is practicable. Thank you.
