

Timeline of Santa Clara Family Community Interim Housing Project

July 13, 2021	City Council study session on Project Homekey
August 24, 2021	City Council study session on Homelessness, feedback to apply to Project Homekey for transitional housing site
November 9, 2021	City Council study session, feedback to continue to work with LifeMoves to identify a site within Santa Clara
November 2021	County Board directs County Office of Supportive Housing (OSH) to identify potential sites for interim housing in proximity to services and to work with local jurisdictions to bring forward projects
April – October 2022	City's Homelessness Taskforce identifies need for interim housing in Santa Clara
Fall 2022	LifeMoves and Sobrato Philanthropies approach County with proposal to build interim supportive housing at Lawrence-Benton site
January 10, 2023	City Council feedback to conduct outreach and explore interim housing at the Lawrence/Benton site
Early 2023	City, County and LifeMoves staff conduct outreach including two in-person meetings and two virtual meetings. Meetings were well attended and community members raised concerns about the suitability of the site, impacts on public safety, and the viability of the project.
2023	Project team makes significant changes to the project reducing density from 124 units to 30 units and changing the target population from singles to families with children.
May 2, 2023 June 27, 2023	City Council authorizes the City Manager's office to negotiate and execute a three-party letter of intent between the City, County and LifeMoves and allocated \$6.5 million in funding for operations of the project.
July 2023	County submits a Homekey application to HCD.

May 6, 2025	State awards \$25.7 million in Homekey Round 3 funds to the project.
July, 2026	Building Permit, NEPA, Revenue Agreement
