March: Irish-American History Month

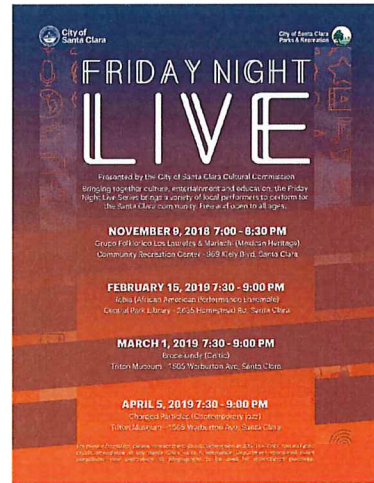

 - Apr 25th – Participation in Arbor Day field trips with SCUSD (900 students)

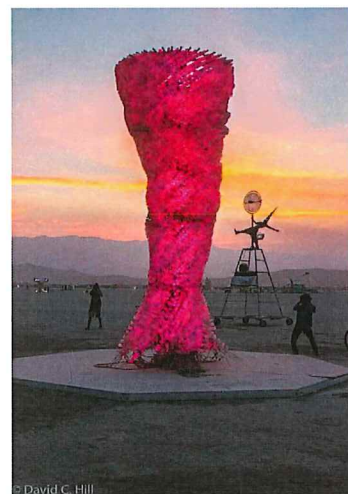
