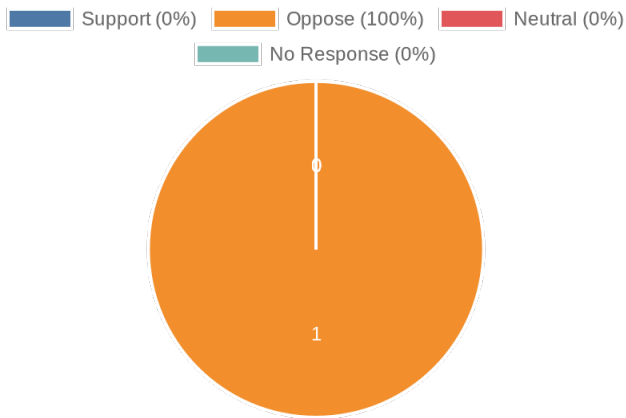

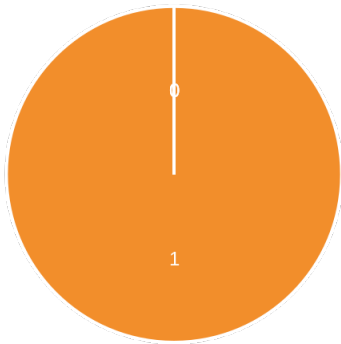
### Overall Sentiment
