User Fee & Cost of Services Study

- Departments studied include:
 - Community Development Planning
 - Finance Municipal Services
 - Library
 - Parks and Recreation Cemetery only
 - Police
 - Water and Sewer
- · Non-studied departments used 3.5% CPI factor to update their fees

- Fees will be effective July 1, 2017




2017-18 Proposed Municipal Fee Schedule
