immediately; (2) staff shall return to Council/Board with a report presented at a public meeting with: (a) summary of lessons learned from Super Bowl operations to inform preparation for the upcoming FIFA World Cup, understanding the need for confidentiality of certain security related matters; (b) information regarding data sharing policies; and (c) opportunities for updates or refinements to City Council Policy 056; and (3) modify Section B.4 of City Council Policy 056 to provide training and reporting procedure for City employees.

MEETING DISCLOSURES

The time limit within which to commence any lawsuit or legal challenge to any quasi-adjudicative decision made by the City is governed by Section 1094.6 of the Code of Civil Procedure, unless a shorter limitation period is specified by any other provision. Under Section 1094.6, any lawsuit or legal challenge to any quasi-adjudicative decision made by the City must be filed no later than the 90th day following the date on which such decision becomes final. Any lawsuit or legal challenge, which is not filed within that 90-day period, will be barred. If a person wishes to challenge the nature of the above section in court, they may be limited to raising only those issues they or someone else raised at the meeting described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City of Santa Clara, at or prior to the meeting. In addition, judicial challenge may be limited or barred where the interested party has not sought and exhausted all available administrative remedies.
