A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SANTA CLARA, CALIFORNIA, ORDERING THE VACATION OF STORM DRAIN EASEMENT, STREET AND UTILITY EASEMENT, ELECTRIC EASEMENT, AND WIRE CLEARANCE EASEMENT AT 2200 CALLE DE LUNA [APN 097-01-039 (2022-23)]

- (b) The date of dedication or acquisition is less than five years, and more than one year, immediately preceding the proposed vacation, and the easement was not used continuously since that date.

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(c) The easement has been superseded by relocation, or determined to be excess

by the easement holder, and there are no other public facilities located within the easement.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF SANTA CLARA AS FOLLOWS:

1. That said Easements shown in said Exhibits have been superseded by relocation, or

determined to be excess by the easement holders, and there are no other public facilities

located within the easements.

2. That said Easements described and shown in said Exhibits in the City are hereby

vacated pursuant to California Streets and Highways Code Section 8333.

3. That the vacation hereby releases all easement rights and interest of the City referred in

said Exhibits to the current property owner(s).

4. <u>Effective date</u>. This resolution shall become effective immediately.
