



Application for Neighborhood University Relations Committee (NURC)

The Neighborhood University Relations Committee is a City Council outside agency Committee and forum for on-going communication and problem solving. It was initially formed in 2006 and has consisted of three City Councilmembers as Committee members with participation by City staff, Santa Clara University staff, Santa Clara students, as well as property owners and residents that reside near the Santa Clara University. On April 8, 2025, the City Council took action to change the structure of the NURC to be inclusive of stakeholders and added new Committee Members. The NURC now consists of a total of seven members including two Councilmembers, two Santa Clara University staff, one Santa Clara University student, one resident of the Old Quad Neighborhood, and one property owner/landlord representative of the Old Quad Neighborhood. The City Councilmembers who serve as Committee members will be selected by the City Council, and the Santa Clara University staff members and student will be selected by Santa Clara University. Once selected, the NURC Committee members will be appointed by the City Council.

Position

The City is recruiting to fill two community based NURC Committee member positions. One Committee member to serve in the Resident role and one Committee member to serve in the Property Owner/ Landlord Representative role. It is intended for both of these Committee members to represent the Old Quad Neighborhood.

The Resident role will require evidence of residing in the boundaries of the Old Quad Neighborhood.

The Property Owner/Landlord Representative role will require evidence of ownership or representing ownership of property specifically used for rental housing.

The Old Quad Neighborhood is generally the area of the City of Santa Clara, south of the Caltrain railroad tracks and north of Newhall Street. The **Old Quad Map** depicts the specific boundary lines.

I own a rental within the old quad boundaries additionally I want students and residents to live harmoniously and productively without incidents while keeping landlords aware of the Neighborhood University Relations Committee's efforts to make Santa Clara University students living the best it can be. One concern I have and would like to address are the number of accidents that occur at the intersection of Monroe and Newhall. I realize only one corner, the north east corner of the intersection is within the city of Santa Clara boundaries; however the intersection is traveled often at a high rate of speed and is an unprotected left turn from Monroe onto Newhall. Last April a sign was posted on the signal above Monroe Street but this has not seemed to prevent the many accidents that occur there.
