#### **Solid Waste Rates**

- Services
  - -Garbage
  - -Yard Trimmings
  - -Residential Recycling
  - -Clean-up Campaign (CUC)
- Rates for each service that a customer subscribes to get combined into a bundled rate



## **Compensation Adjustments**

- Effective July 1, 2024
  - MTWS increase @ 5.0% based on WST Index
  - -GWR increase @ 2.6% based on Bay Area CPI
  - Recology increase @ 5.3%
    - Route growth increase
    - WST Index
  - Republic increase estimated @ 3% based on 80% CPI; 10%
    Employment Cost Index; 10% Gross National Product
    Implicit Price Deflator

- Most jurisdictions have a separate charge for organics collection service

#### **Public Hearing**

- Solid waste customers may submit oral or written protests until the close of the Public Hearing
- · At close of Public Hearing, protests are tabulated
  - -34,948 notices were sent on April 17, 2024
  - -If protests tabulated are 50 percent plus one (17,475), the proposed fees cannot be imposed
- If there is not a majority protest, Council can make and act on a motion to increase fees

# Santa Clara residents will experience rate hikes up to 87% from '19-20 rates under current proposal


