Recommendation:

Patty Wong, City Librarian informed the **Board** that item 2, the recommendation for **City Council** to adopt a Resolution to establish the 2024 Calendar of Meetings for the **Board of Library Trustees**, had been approved previously by the **Board**, and was returned to their attention to approve a change, removing the word "hybrid" from the Resolution. The **Board** was informed that there would continue to be an effort to hold **Board of Library Trustees** regular meetings in a hybrid manner, but there was a concern that it may not always be technically possible to do so, while the inclusion of the term "hybrid" in the Resolution would make this mandatory.

The **Board** reviewed presentation slides summarizing **Board** accomplishments and talking points for the planned upcoming **Board** dinner with **City Council**. **Trustees** shared their draft talking points with the **Board**, and recommended revisions for the presentation, which will be shared by **Staff** at the next regular **Board of Library Trustees** meeting.

The **Board** also recommended adding some work plan goals to the draft work plan goals outlined for Calendar Year 2024, including support of the Strategic Plan, Facilities Master Plan, further development of the New Trustee Handbook, and advocating for additional funding for the **Library** collection.

MEETING DISCLOSURES

The time limit within which to commence any lawsuit or legal challenge to any quasi-judicative decision made by the City is governed by Section 1094.6 of the Code of Civil Procedure, unless a shorter limitation period is specified by any other provision. Under Section 1094.6, any lawsuit or legal challenge to any quasi-judicative decision made by the City must be filed no later than the 90th day following the date on which such decision becomes final. Any lawsuit or legal challenge, which is not filed within that 90-day period, will be barred. If a person wishes to challenge the nature of the above section in court, they may be limited to raising only those issues they or someone else raised at the meeting described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City of Santa Clara, at or prior to the meeting. In addition, judicial challenge may be limited or barred where the interested party has not sought and exhausted all available administrative remedies.

If a member of the public submits a speaker card for any agenda items, their name will appear in the Minutes. If no speaker card is submitted, the Minutes will reflect "Public Speaker."

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
