Retired Santa Clara Police Department Lieutenant Charles “Chuck” Seymour

- Chuck Seymour was born on January 5, 1943.
- In 1965, he was hired at the Santa Clara Police Department as a Patrolman.
- Chuck was promoted to Police Sergeant in March of 1975 and in 1984, he was promoted again to the rank of Police Lieutenant.
- Chuck retired in August 1996 after 32 years of dedicated service to the City of Santa Clara.
- He continued to serve the community in the capacity of Parks and Recreation Commissioner.
- Chuck Seymour passed away on December 26, 2019 after a short illness.
- He is survived by his children Ashley Zmuda, Jon Seymour, and Lisa Seymour-Nunes.

E. Jackson Going, Jr., Longtime Santa Clara Resident and Founding Member of the Santa Clara University Board of Fellows

- E. Jackson (Jack) Going was born on February 22, 1928, in Texas but lived the majority of his life in Santa Clara County.
- He graduated from Bellarmine College Preparatory at the age of 16.
- In 1949, he graduated from Santa Clara University.
- Jack co-founded the civil engineering firm Ruth and Going, Inc. where he worked until his retirement in 1984.
- Jack gave back to the community for decade as a founding member of the Santa Clara University Board of Fellows and an original board member of the Second Harvest Food Bank.

- He served on many governmental commissions, charitable organizations and was named recipient of the Austin Warburton Community Service Award from the Mission City Community Fund in 1999.
- Jack led the long effort to reroute The Alameda around Santa Clara University, which was completed in 1989. A plaque in his honor is on the Santa Clara University campus in grateful recognition of this accomplishment.
- E. Jackson Going, Jr. passed away on December 30, 2019; he was predeceased by his wife of 56 years, Audrey B. Going, and is survived by a son and daughter as well as 7 grandchildren.
