- Michael DeYoung passed away on October 12, 2024.
- Mike was born in Rochester, NY on July 16, 1951 to Charles and Joan DeYoung.
- He Graduated from Olympia High School with a Regents diploma.
- Mike was an Eagle Scout, motorcycle enthusiast, avid camper and known by his worn smile.
- The great music lover, Mike attended Woodstock in 1969 earning "hippy" status in the eyes
 of his son Charles.
- Mike studied business and field service management at Monroe Community College, where he was Student Body President.
- A long-time Kodak employee, Mike relocated to the San Francisco Bay Area in 1979; never actually retiring, he enjoyed a successful career in materials management and logistics and planning; he worked with local and international organizations, most recently Thermo Fisher Scientific.
