Park History

- Dedicated in 1954
- Warburton Swim Center opened in 1962
- Park was renovated in 1963
- Named for Austen D.
 Warburton, a Parks and
 Recreation Commissioner
 known as "Mr. Santa Clara"
- Facility Assessment Report completed in 2018 (Kitchell)







Park Site

- Located in neighborhood of homes.
- Pool facility
- Basketball courts
- Picnic areas
- Parking lot
- Playground
- Open grass area

Site Assessment

- Outdated playground is in poor condition, not accessible by wheelchair
- Many unhealthy trees
- Walkways do not meet current standards
- Access from ADA parking stalls does not meet current code

 Facility Condition Assessment Report by Kitchell






Site Analysis
