Sun: Closed


- Phase 1

- All programming still virtual




Current vs. pre-COVID

- Library is open 28% of pre-COVID hours
- Circulation is at 46% of pre-COVID totals
- Demand for materials is strong

E-media Usage

- 13,500 checkouts per month pre-COVID
- Monthly checkouts increased by 300% since February 2020

E-media Checkout






Materials on Hold






Patron Visits

Patron Visits






Recent Patron Visits

- Central expanded indoor services in late August


Recent Patron Visits
