POSITIONS ON NON-CITY-RELATED ISSUES

POLICY

Traditionally, the City does not take a position on non-City-related issues. City Council approval is required.

PROCEDURE

- 1. An individual or organization may ask the City to take a position supporting or opposing non-City-related issues. City Council approval is required.
- 2. Staff reviews the request for support or opposition, noting applicability to municipal concerns.
- 3. Staff makes a recommendation to the City Council to support, oppose, or take no action/position on the item based on its applicability to municipal concerns, and direct City impact.
- 4. The City Council takes action.
