- One vacancy on the Commission.



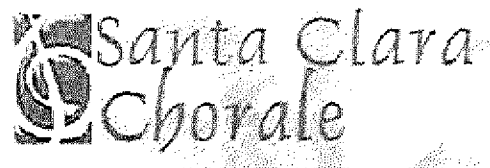
Duties of the Commission

- Commissioners encourage educational, cultural, sports, technical and governmental exchanges.



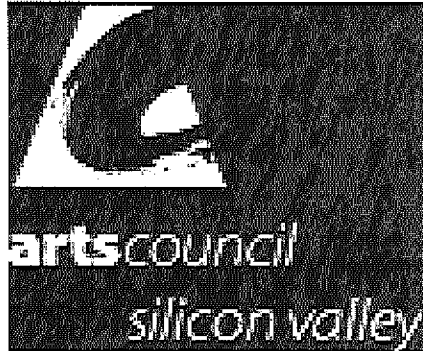


