Item # 6: Mobile Food Vendors Ordinance

18.60.280 – Mobile Food Vendors

- Zoning Code Update Adopted in January in 2024
- With the effective date of the newly adopted zoning map on August 15, 2024, all sections of the updated Zoning Code became effective, including **provisions for Mobile Food Vendors** (*on private property*).
- Mobile Food Vendors can operate in Commercial, Mixed-Use, Office and Industrial zoning districts.
- Prior to the Updated Zoning Code there were no regulations for Mobile Food Vendors (*on private property*).



Purpose and Intent

Encourage mobile food vending that is compatible with associated and surrounding uses and do not obstruct pedestrian or vehicular circulation or create an unsightly appearance.



Development Standards

- Location (*a fixed*, *specifically approved location*)
- Hours of Operation (*within 100 feet of a residential use, limited to 7 am to 10 pm daily*)
- Signs (none allowed above what is allowed for the on-site business)
- Distance from Residential Uses (no less than 100 feet from the property line of a residentially zoned parcel without prior approval of a Minor Use Permit)

- Maintenance (kept free of garbage and other debris)
 - **Operational Standards:**
 - County Public Health clearance
 - Trash cans
 - Seating limited to 500 square feet of area max. and 24 seats max.
 - Not obstruct public right-of-way, fire, pedestrian, and wheelchair access
 - No amplified sound
 - No additional parking required
 - Temporary canopies removed nightly



Permit Requirements

- When operating for less than two hours: <u>no permit is required</u>
- When operating for more than two hours but less than four hours on a site: <u>Zoning Clearance is required (administrative)</u>
- When operating for more than four hours on a site, or when operating within 100 feet of a residentially zoned parcel: <u>Minor Use Permit is required</u> (noticing to adjacent properties public hearing held if requested)
