Overview


BACKGROUND

- The City of Santa Clara receives entitlement funding from the US Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).
- The purpose of this funding is to benefit low income households by providing affordable housing and community development services.
- Activities and programs funded must address the needs and priorities detailed in the City's 5-Year Consolidated Action Plan.
- Tonight's public hearing provides a final opportunity for public input on the 19/20 Annual Action Plan.

- Approve the FY 19/20 Annual Action Plan, and direct staff to incorporate all public comments to be submitted to HUD on or before May 15, 2019.

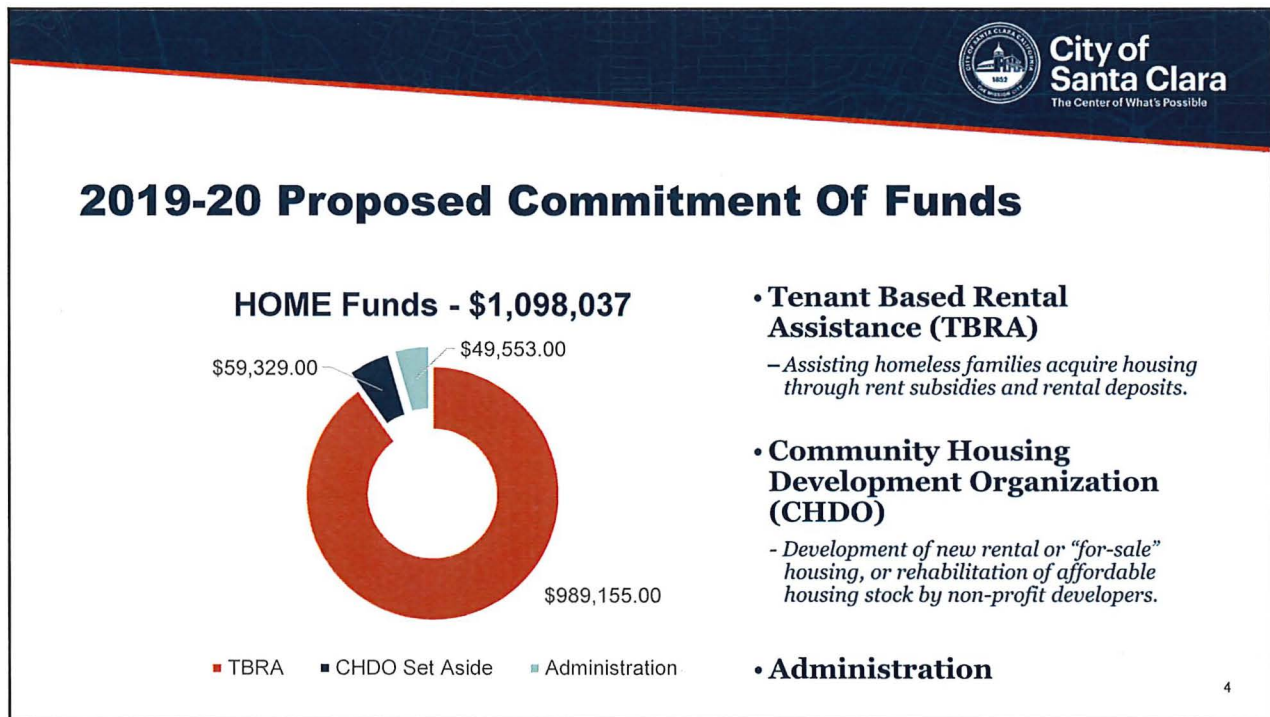

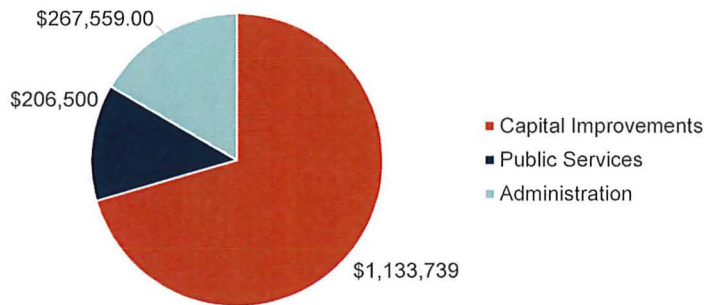
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2019-20 Proposed Commitment Of Funds

• Administration

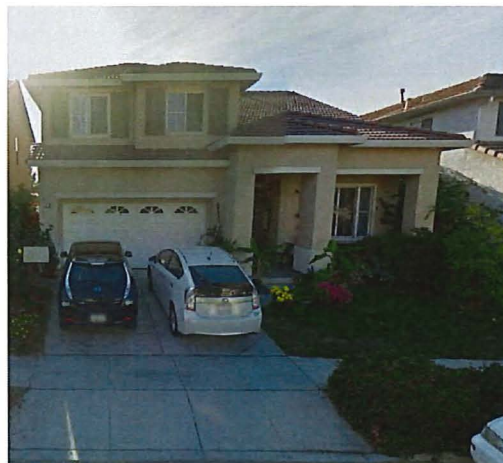


2018-2019 Results & Beneficiaries (to date)
