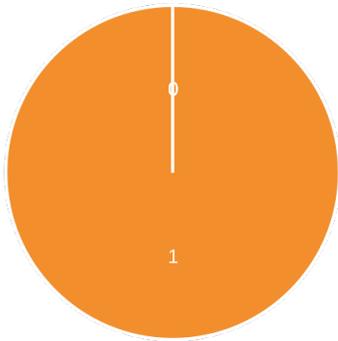

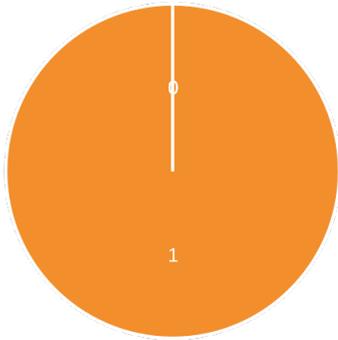

Overall Sentiment

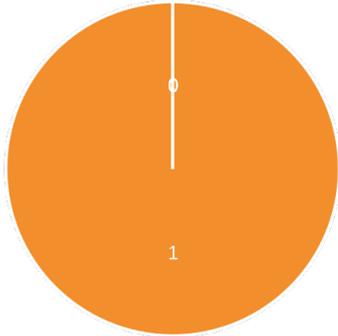

I am commenting in vehement opposition to the proposed field usage fees specifically as they pertain to a youth non-profit, non-resident category, which has been eliminated (previously was a youth non-profit category) and lumped in with a single non-resident category. The fees for this category (which are 20 TIMES HIGHER than for resident non-profit categories) are the same as what is being proposed for the Commercial category, which would apply to companies like Google, Meta, and Apple.
