## LifeMoves in Mt View

- •Current Mountain View Homelessness Count: 606\*
- •Public/Private Partnership: State of California, City of Mountain View, Santa Clara County, <u>LifeMoves</u>
- •100 doors (with up to 124 beds) for homeless families, seniors, disabled individuals
- •Project Homekey funding \$14.35 million total
- •Rapid occupancy starting in spring 2021
- •Provides 2x Mountain View's cold-weather beds and 10x current year-round beds (13 to ~136)
- •Will serve 350+ individuals over the course of a year (2-3x turnover of beds)
- •20% impact overnight on people experiencing homelessness in Mountain View
- •60% impact in first year on people experiencing homelessness in Mountain View
- •< \$95k/door with land vs. hotel \$200k/door vs. housing unit \$450-750k/door</p>
- Low Operating Cost: \$60/night vs. homeless on-street/hotel/jail \$171\*\* -\$222/night\*\*
- •Private rooms for every individual/family: provides dignified living space
