SB 9 has stripped homeowners', who purchased Single-Family homes in Very Low-Density neighborhoods, from being able to enjoy a reasonable amount of privacy. It has done away with long established setbacks that were designed to protect neighboring property owners' privacy. SB 9 has given homeowners and developers permission to turn 6,000 sq. ft homesites into two story mini apartment complexes with up to 4 units on each lot. This Bill effectively changed the zoning from 7 single-family homes per acre to 28 units an acre... with no community input! However, SB 9 also allows for the City of Santa Clara to establish "Objective Zoning Standards".
