MEETING DISCLOSURES

The time limit within which to commence any lawsuit or legal challenge to any quasi-adjudicative decision made by the City is governed by Section 1094.6 of the Code of Civil Procedure, unless a shorter limitation period is specified by any other provision. Under Section 1094.6, any lawsuit or legal challenge to any quasi-adjudicative decision made by the City must be filed no later than the 90th day following the date on which such decision becomes final. Any lawsuit or legal challenge, which is not filed within that 90-day period, will be barred. If a person wishes to challenge the nature of the above section in court, they may be limited to raising only those issues they or someone else raised at the meeting described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City of Santa Clara, at or prior to the meeting. In addition, judicial challenge may be limited or barred where the interested party has not sought and exhausted all available administrative remedies.

Now that I have completed my Masters in Social Work at San Jose State University and started a new career as a child welfare social worker with the County of Santa Clara Department of Family and Children's Services, I have the free time needed to join a city commission and am excited for this opportunity. <u>Please state reasons why you want to become a member of this Board/Commission/Committee,</u> <u>including what specific objectives you would be working toward as a member of this advisory</u> <u>board:</u>

I am Vietnamese Americans who came to live in Santa Clara in 1987. I left Omaha, NE after fully assimilated for 11 years into the American life. I came to Santa Clara and love this community which I see as my home. My husband has built his business here as well as settling in a nice home in the Rivermark community, near the Levi's stadium.

I have lived in Santa Clara for more than 8 years but worked in the Santa Clara City for more than 28 years.

Although I have not attended the past board meetings, I am familiar with the physical challenges that our city faces, home construction is few but more affordable homes are needed; social gatherings have become condensed and parking spaces are also problem; parks are needed and frequently used by families but for parks in less frequented areas, it needs to be safe for social gathering; young adults need to have a healthy location for safe socializing and learning about themselves. Our city is so wonderfully diverse that we should embrace the differences and boasts about the common bonds that we all hold. We also have a diverse layers of economic differences where working families make less than \$50K per year or even \$75K oer year as a household. How are we serving those families and their needs? Not everyone makes >\$100K per year; we also have an older population who should be served and nurtured as well. The services that we provide and seek should complement their experiences. Our programs should take advantage of the wise and experienced demographics and mix them with the young adults, toddlers, or people with different abilities. The continued interest in the Levi's stadium and its on-going noise issue should be monitored but with a neighborhood group. Together, as partners we shall have a productive dialogue to make our city the best city in California.

I am active in all past activities which my daughter was involved since middle school to high school. We have attended parks, swam, and attended cultural and sporting events here. I have seen how the pools and showers have been managed. At the time, I wish I could fix things. I wish I could influence decisions to have better management, etc. In the past, our family were active with the community to improve its infrastructure and governance. We donate or attend events and endorsed the City's initiatives.

I am aware of the meeting times, date, and month and have committed to attending in case I am selected. I look forward to meeting you at the Board Meeting.
