- Tilly Goldsberry was born on October 2, 1924, the daughter of Delores and Joseph Rodriguez, immigrants from Spain.
- She was married to Tex Goldsberry, who pre-deceased her in 1992.
- They were both active in the American Legion Post 419.
- They raised 3 daughters and were longtime Santa Clara residents, growing up in "Spanish Town".
- Tilly was a multi-year volunteer with the Police Activity League, she organized with Lou Piro the girls softball and goodie wagon, and was a member of the Santa Clara Women's League.
- For over 30 years she volunteered at the Senior Center and was active for many years in lead positions for the Santa Clara Unified School District PTA'S.
- Tilly was 97 years old when she passed away on Tuesday, June 28th, 2022.
- She is survived by her daughters: Donna, Gloria and Linda, 5 grandchildren and 4 great grandchildren.
- Tilly Goldsberry will be deeply missed by her friends, family and all those whose lives she touched through her dedicated volunteer work.
