Relay For Life is the signature fundraiser for the American Cancer Society. Relay events are staffed and coordinated by volunteers in more than 5,200 communities and 27 countries. Teams raise funds in the months leading up to the Relay event and then camp out at local schools, parks, or fairgrounds and take turns walking or running around a track or path. Each team is asked to have a representative on the track at all times, while entertainment, music, and fun activities keep things lively. Symbolizing the battle waged around the clock by those facing cancer, the event lasts up to 24 hours and empowers communities and individuals to join the fight for a world without cancer.






RELAY FOR LIFE PARTICIPANTS ACROSS THE US*


