# Santa Clara Stadium Authority FY 2018-19 Capital Budget

#### **Total Capital Budget of \$7.9 million**

- Stadium Improvements \$6,227,469
  - Community room build out of \$630,000
  - Public Safety Budget of \$1,757,000
    - Carryforward of \$1,140,000 for Street Signage, Cad Replacement, and Med Cart upgrade
- Stadium Warranty Related Construction \$1,653,270
  - Part of the original Stadium Development/Construction Budget



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#### FY 2017-18 Budget Modification

- Operating Fund Increase SBL proceeds by \$3.7 million due to higher than anticipated SBL proceeds received in March 2018.
  - SBL proceeds can only be used for debt service per Article III of the Amended and Restated Deposit and Disbursement Agreement.
- Debt Service Fund Increase in transfers-out from the operating budget fund and a corresponding increase of transfers-in to the debt service fund to pay for additional debt service in the amount of \$13.5 million.
  - SBL proceeds
  - Applied to Subordinated Loan
