We also ask City Attorney Brian Doyle to provide us with the actions the City Council may take to reprimand Councilman Caserta if appropriate. This should include but not be limited to the following:

- a request for him to resign,
- a censure by the council,
- removal from council committees,
- restrictions on representing the council in an official capacity at public events, and
- a decision to consider his absence from council meetings to be "unexcused" unless he provides evidence of a legitimate reason for his absence.
