



FIREWORKS DISPLAY PERMIT

POLICY

A fireworks display permit may be issued once certain criteria have been met which provide for Fire Department safety standards.

PROCEDURE

1. The applicant shall submit a written request to the Fire Marshal, along with a Public Fireworks Display Permit Application from the State Fire Marshal's Office.
2. When applying for the permit, the applicant shall submit a permit fee of \$90.00 to the Fire Marshal's Office.
3. The Fire Marshal reviews the application for permit.
4. The Fire Marshal inspects the proposed fireworks display site.
5. The Fire Marshal observes the actual fireworks display.
6. The Fire Marshal signs the permit for compliance after the fireworks display is finished and gives or mails this to a representative of the group in charge of the fireworks display.
7. The fireworks company will submit a "Pyrotechnic Operators Public Display Report" to the Fire Marshal's Office within thirty days of the display.
