**A RESOLUTION OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF THE
CITY OF SANTA CLARA, CALIFORNIA MAKING FINDINGS ON
THE CONFORMITY OF THE FISCAL YEAR 2018-2019
CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM BUDGET WITH THE
2010-2035 GENERAL PLAN**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SANTA CLARA AS
FOLLOWS:**

WHEREAS, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SANTA
CLARA AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, a list of capital improvement projects from the City of Santa Clara Capital
Improvement Program ("CIP") Budget for Fiscal Year 2018-2019 is attached hereto and
incorporated herein as Exhibit 1 ("Proposed FY 2018-2019 CIP Budget"). This list was
submitted to the Planning Commission on May 23, 2018 for the Commission's review and report
as to the conformity of the CIP with the General Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission reviewed and considered the Proposed FY 2018-2019
CIP Budget to determine whether the list of proposed public works is consistent with the Santa
Clara 2010-2035 General Plan pursuant to the requirements of State law.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF
THE CITY OF SANTA CLARA AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That the Planning Commission hereby determines that all of the projects listed in the
Proposed FY 2018-2019 CIP Budget conform with the Santa Clara 2010-2035 General Plan,
with the exception of the Morse Mansion Rehabilitation project, which the Planning Commission
finds is not consistent with the General Plan Major Strategy to Maintain the City's Fiscal Health
and Quality Services.
2. That the Fiscal Year 2018-2019 Proposed Capital Improvement Project Budget takes
into consideration the City of Santa Clara Budget Guiding Principles for 2018-2019.

3. Constitutionality, severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this resolution is for any reason held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the resolution. The City of Santa Clara, California, hereby declares that it would have passed this resolution and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, and word thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more section(s), subsection(s), sentence(s), clause(s), phrase(s), or word(s) be declared invalid.

5. Effective date. This resolution shall become effective immediately.
