A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SANTA CLARA, CALIFORNIA REVISING THE CURRENT TITLE OF THE GENERAL FUND WORKING CAPITAL RESERVE TO THE NEW TITLE OF THE GENERAL FUND BUDGET STABILIZATION RESERVE

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF SANTA CLARA AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 5052 of the City Council of the City of Santa Clara set a Reserve for Working Capital, passed and adopted at a regular meeting held on the 1st day of April, 1986;

WHEREAS, to provide more clarity and avoid confusion with the General Fund Capital Reserve, the title of the Working Capital Reserve is being renamed to the Budget Stabilization Reserve;

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Budget Stabilization Reserve is to provide funding should a deficiency develop in the general operating funds' capacity to meet operating costs for any purpose, and funds may be withdrawn from this fund to pay such costs;

WHEREAS, Monies shall be transferred to the Budget Stabilization Reserve in the amount of 25% (90 days of operations) of the Budgeted General Fund appropriations if available.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF SANTA CLARA AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That the Working Capital Reserve be renamed to Budget Stabilization Reserve;
- That the Budget Stabilization Reserve be funded by 25% of Budgeted General Fund Appropriations if available; and
- 3. Effective date. This resolution shall become effective immediately.
