 - ✓ SCSA staff participation in Concessionaire Contract
 - ✓ SCSA assisted with Parking and Concession audit
 - ✓ CFP agreement protecting the Stadium Authority
 - ✓ Transparent Budget and Marketing Plan

- 68% of audit recommendations are complete
- 40% increase in completed recommendations since March

Outstanding Audit Recommendations

- 12 audit recommendations are partially complete
- Some are difficult to implement as they require cooperation, collaboration, and/or consent from ManCo and/or StadCo
- Staff will return to the Committee in March/April of 2019 to provide an update on the status of the remaining audit recommendations

Net Revenue for Non-NFL Events

- Concerts, Soccer, and Special Events (weddings, corporate events, birthday parties) are positive revenue generators
- Non-NFL Football events (college and high school) have generated substantial losses all four years
- Aligns with the Board's action to establish a separate agreement for the College Football Playoff (CFP) which saved the Stadium Authority from carrying an estimated \$12 million plus loss



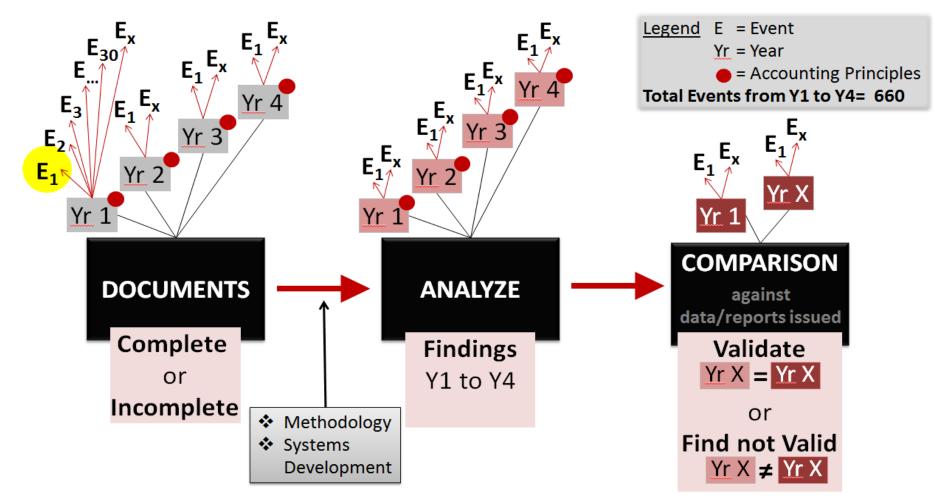

Status and Observations

- Independent Review of Documentation
- Current review of Non-NFL event documentation has revealed some discrepancies:
 - ManCo is in the process of providing additional information to explain the differences
- The position of Stadium Auditor is now filled
 - Provides in-house Audit expertise
 - Review of SCSA processes is currently underway
 - Establishing audit procedures to be used by SCSA staff for review of documents
