Request for Proposal (RFP)

- A Request for Proposal for Food and Beverage Operations for the Santa Clara Convention Center was released on May 13, 2019.
- The final agreement will be between the City and the selected food and beverage vendor.
- Will follow the same procurement strategy and process utilized for the RFP for the management and operation of the Convention Center:
 - Procurement Process Integrity and Conflict of Interest Guidelines; E-Procurement tool BidSync; Reference to the City's Worker Retention Ordinance is included in the RFP document; timeline allows for submission of Best and Final Offer, Notice of Intended Award, and a 10-day protest period.

RFP Overview

- Evaluation will be structured in two phases
 - Phase I: Based on the firm's operating experience, innovation, and proposed solution
 - Phase 2: Will evaluate the quality of the proposal through oral presentations and menu/food sampling
- Five-member evaluation team comprised of subject matter experts from inside and outside the City
- Evaluation team will be advised by Jones Lang LaSalle (JLL)
