Dear Mayor Mahan and Council Members:

We are writing to amend our letter dated August 23, 2006. We believe that the following modification to the initial proposal to the City of Santa Clara will help clarify and expedite the process.

As such, we respectfully request that the City of Santa Clara take proper action in the following specific areas:

- 1) Take necessary steps to help Korean American merchants post English signs,
- 2) Mount one monument sign on a median on El Camino Real near Lawrence Expressway (We are **NOT** interested in extending the sign to Lafayette),
- 3) Post exit signs on the 280 and 101 freeways near the Lawrence Expressway exits and on the 880 freeway near the Alameda exit,
- 4) Help to erect a Korean American community symbol in Heritage Park, and *Central?*
- 5) Hire Korean language speaking police officers in the city's police department.

We believe that the above proposal will increase the city's revenues, employment opportunities, and safety of residences and business persons.
