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

In the City of Santa Clara, Healthier Kids Foundation screens children for untreated vision, dental, and hearing issues; case managers follow-up with the parents of all children who receive a screening result that identifies an issue. This ensures that each child gets the care they need so that they are able to learn in the classroom. Healthier Kids Foundation also delivers 10 Steps to a Healthier You! workshops to parents and caregivers in the City of Santa Clara, providing strategies to implement healthy habits in the home.

Of those who attended a 10 Steps workshop:

- 97% felt that they had learned new things that they would go home and try
- 90% felt that the class was very or extremely valuable

At the end of quarter four, Healthier Kids Foundation has identified the following in the City of Santa Clara:

- 136 children with untreated vision problems (11% referral rate)
- 195 children with urgent or emergency dental needs (24% referral rate)
- 83 children with untreated hearing problems (13% referral rate)

Healthier Kids Foundation case managers are currently working with these families to ensure that the children receive appropriate treatment through their insurance. If uninsured, the case manager assists the family in enrolling into subsidized health insurance. At the close of year:

- 38 children have received glasses, 77 went to an optometrist for follow up
- 85 children received dental services
- 53 children obtained appreciate hearing services

Without our partnership with the city, these kids' needs could have remained unidentified, unaddressed and might have been barriers to learning. Healthier Kids Foundation is still working with families on 100 cases that are still open to ensure their children get the care they need to be healthy and successful (73% dental, 27% vision).

In addition to providing direct services to Santa Clara residents, Healthier Kids Foundation provided the following during quarter four:

- hosted monthly Santa Clara Challenge Team meetings to bring together community partners and discuss the well-being of families in the city and resources that are available
- 2. provided resources and screenings at the Egg-Stravaganza
- 3. patnered with the Central Library and Mayor Gillmor for Storytime
- 4. hosted the 3rd Annual City of Santa Clara Essay Contest and Awards Banquet

- 250 children dental screened through DentalFirst program
- 250 children hearing screened through HearingFirst program
