**William D. "Denny" Weisgerber, former Mayor of Milpitas**

- Denny Weisgerber was born in Bend, Oregon on May 5, 1930. He graduated with a BA in Business Administration from the University of San Francisco.
- Denny married Marianne Weisgerber in February 1949, the same month he enlisted in the Marines.
- Denny Weisgerber served in Korea as an assistant platoon sergeant, where he saw major combat. For his valor, he was awarded the Navy Cross.
- Denny was also a recipient of the National Defense Medal, Purple Heart, United Nations Korea Medal, Navy Unit Commendation Medal, Good Conduct Medal, Korean Campaign Medal (two stars), Combat Action Ribbon, and Presidential Unit Citation.
- He was a two-time Milpitas Rotary Club President, and three-time Milpitas Mayor during a 12-year City Council run from the 1960s into the early 1970s.
- Denny Weisgerber passed away on December 4, 2019. He was predeceased by his wife, Marianne, and is survived by two children, five grandchildren, and seven great-grandchildren.
