### **Bookmobile Service in Santa Clara**


#### **SUMMARY**

In 2003, due to budget reductions, a changing population, and an underperforming service model, the library retired its Bookmobile Service.

In October 2016, the Irvine Company donated \$250,000 to the City to purchase a Bookmobile to restart and update bookmobile to the City.


The former service model relied on neighborhood stops and schools. The new reenvisioned bookmobile service will meet the changing community needs and serve people where they live, learn, work and play.

Bookmobile service provides critical access to books and resources that promote early childhood literacy, enrich the lives of our seniors, and is a gateway for low income
